## **BEHAVIOUR**

Students who are alleged to have committed miscondwith be referred to the RCM's Deputy Director. They may establish a Panel to consider the student's case. They may ask to see the student concerned and to see the persor making the allegation. If this happens, the student dependence by a parent or guardian or by another student.
